

Privacy Policy

I TRIANGOLI H. S. SRL has adopted internal procedures and corporate policies in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), aimed at ensuring high standards of security and appropriate safeguards for the processing of Personal Data.

Authorised persons to process personal data

Personal data are processed by internal and external staff of the Group companies, duly appointed, instructed and authorised in accordance with Article 29 of the GDPR and relevant national legislation.

Data Retention Period

Personal data shall be retained only for the period strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected and processed, in accordance with the principles set out in Article 5(1)(e) of the GDPR.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on the user's device during navigation on a website. They do not contain executable code and are used to enable certain functionalities, improve user experience, analyse traffic and support security mechanisms. Each domain visited through a browser may install one or more cookies, including third-party cookies. Cookies may allow the website to recognise your device during subsequent visits and preserve previously selected preferences.

The general decision of the Italian Data Protection Authority (Official Gazette no. 126 of 3 June 2014) identifies two main categories of cookies:

- **Technical cookies** – Necessary to ensure the proper functioning of the website and the provision of services requested by the user.
- **Profiling cookies** – Used to monitor user behaviour and preferences in order to deliver personalised advertising content.
